One Large 2-inch binder with zipper or velcro close and a shoulder strap.
*Wal- Mart carries the **Case-it** brand which works very well. These are not the cheapest binder, but they are long lasting. These are the same binders that the children will need for 4th grade so it could be a 2-year investment.*

Two marble covered composition books --->

Two durable folders for homework- no prongs but 3 holes to fit into binder. Your choice of color/design.



One 1-subject spiral notebook

Pack of 3" sticky notes

Two dry erase markers

Pack of Pencils

*** Because our students need to move all of their notebooks, folders and supplies from class to class, their binders can get heavy.
