12. Consideration of Approval for a Second and Final Reading – School Board Policy
  - A. Policy 249 - Bullying/Cyberbullying – The Directors are waiving the first reading and this will be second and final reading.
  - B. Administration has reviewed the policy and has no recommendation for changes.
  - C. The policy remains the same as reviewed by the Board at the last adoption.
  - D. Final approval of the proposed Policy is recommended.

18. Consideration of Approval of Resignation
  - A. Mrs. Michelle Ruland has resigned from her position as Emotional Support Teacher at the General McLane High School effective immediately.
19. Consideration of Approval of Recommendation for Open Position
  - A. Kathy Johnson is recommended for the open Part-Time Art Position at McKean and Edinboro Elementary School. Her salary will be Step 1, Bachelor's plus 15, prorated per number of classes taught.
  - B. Brandon Oathout is recommended for the open Emotional Support position at General McLane High School. His salary will be Step 1, Bachelor's.
  - C. All necessary clearances are on file.
20. Consideration of Approval of Memorandum of Agreement for Career Educational Pathways/Modules Program
  - A. The Career Educational Pathways/Modules Program is a program through Penn State Behrend that will provide college readiness skills to high school student through a set of prescribed courses.
  - B. Students will engage in modules focused on the disciplines of technology and business and upon completion of the modules, students will receive a Penn State Behrend certificate of career/work readiness.
  - C. This is a pilot program with General McLane, Harborcreek and Fort LeBoeuf School Districts.
  - D. Penn State Behrend has withdrawn the request for the commitment of \$5,000 for the modules program.

  - A. Authorization is requested for the Superintendent to execute a settlement agreement in pending litigation involving a legally privileged matter as outlined in the Executive Session on June 18, 2014.
