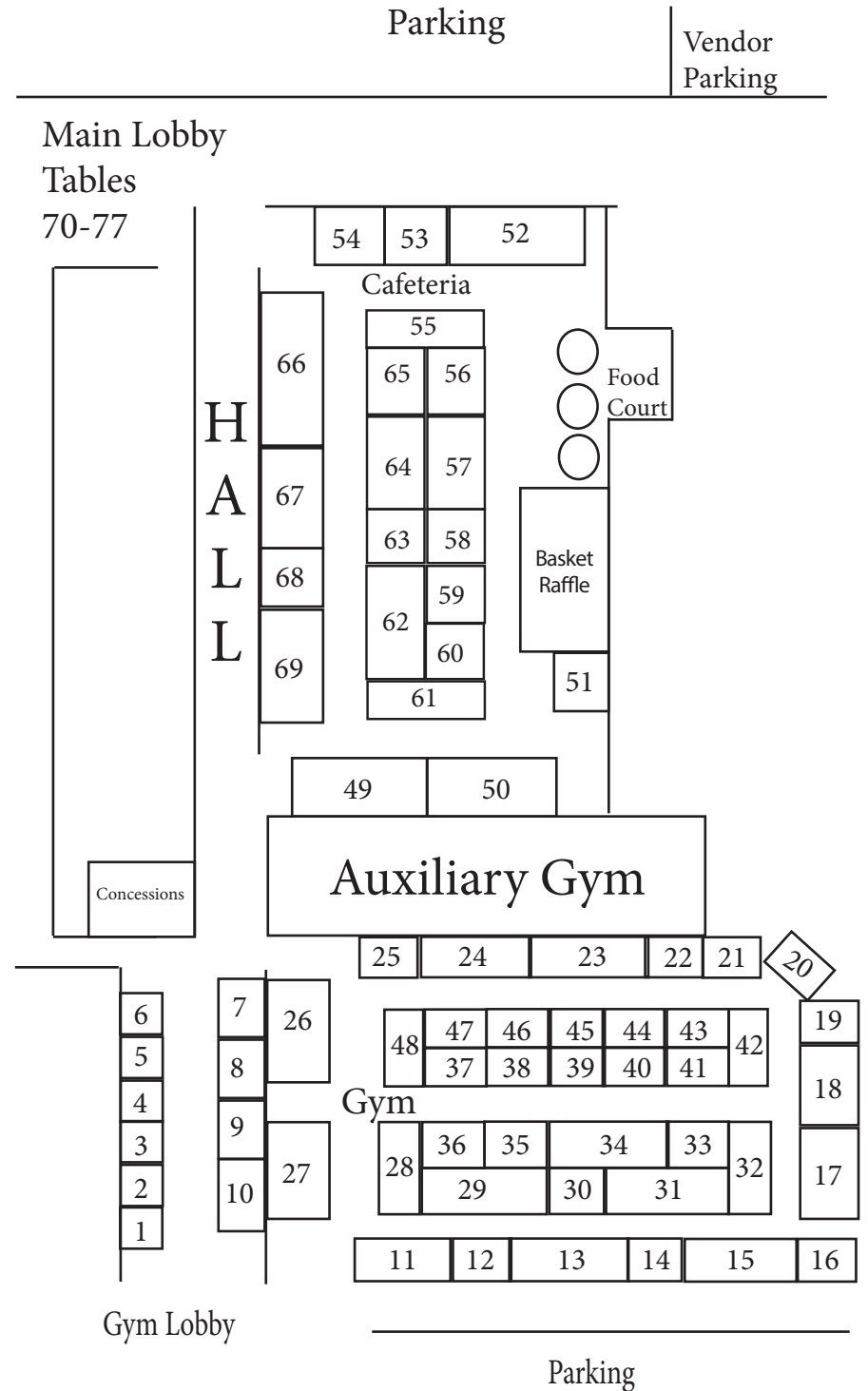

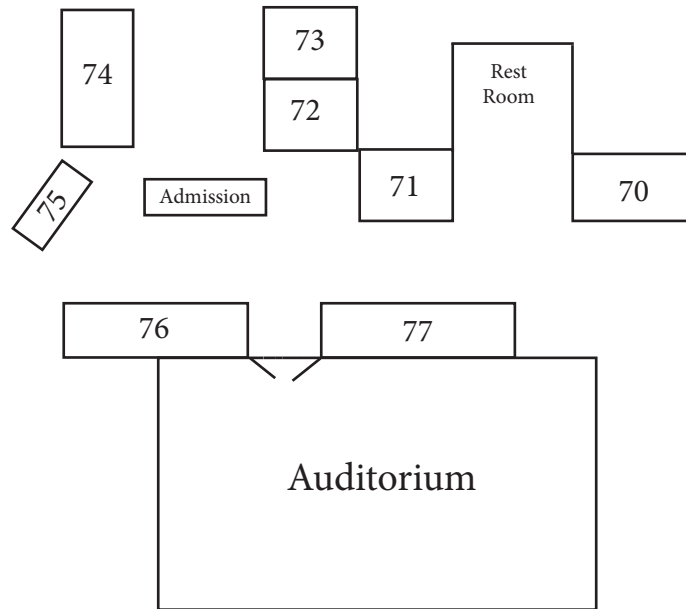

# GM Foundation Funds

The Jim Smart Team Golf Fund supports the Varsity Golf Program.

The James Hill Music Fund is an endowment that supports the Music Department at the High School.

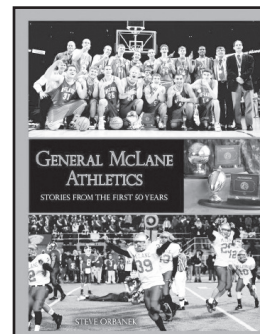
William E. & Mary S. Smith Middle School Innovative Education Fund provides a \$500 mini-grant for middle school teachers to use for an innovative educational program, which is not available through the normal instructional process.

The J.L. Smith Endowment provides a grant to elementary teachers in special area subjects, including health, library, music, art and physical education. This fund was created by Jean Smith, who taught in the District for more than 40 years.

The Student Assistance Fund was created in May, 2013 in order to provide emergency assistance to high school students with personal or educational needs as identified by school district personnel.

The 'M' Fund was created in 2014 by alumni and other supporters to recognize John J. Marszalek for his many years of dedicated service to the GMHS music program. This provides funds to support arts-related events in the GM school district, such as speakers, performers and concerts and to allow faculty, staff and students to participate in educational or performance events not otherwise funded by district or booster funds.

## Scholarship Opportunity for Alumni

## *Scholarships for GM Seniors*

The John Kron Memorial Scholarship, the recipient must show evidence of good citizenship and dependability, have a sense of humor, be involved in community and school activities, be deserving on the basis of character, scholarship and the promise of leadership, and be someone who could use a special boost via this recognition.

The Edwin J. Linden Memorial Scholarship, the recipient has displayed throughout his or her school career the same moral character, integrity, self-control, and discipline as was valued and practiced by the man for whom the award is named.

The James Hill Scholarship, the recipient must also be of sound character and have achieved a 4.0 or higher GPA in the social studies program.

The Janet Clapper Scholarship, the recipient must be a dependable participant in a sport as an athlete, a trainer, or a manager while still maintaining a good academic standing to the best of his or her ability, and must contribute consistently, providing support to the team and assistance wherever it is needed.

The Francis Lamson Scholarship, the recipient must be an outstanding graduating senior who has shown industry, perseverance and enthusiastic attendance in his/her student life.

The Cindy Walker Memorial Scholarship, the recipient must possess the qualities of scholarship, with the emphasis on learning and appreciating knowledge, a positive outlook, no matter what the circumstances and be service-oriented in the school and community.

The Mary Pfeffer Nursing Scholarship, the recipient must be an outstanding senior student going into the profession of nursing.

The Thomas McGinty Art/Music Scholarship, the recipient must be an art or music student that is an outstanding achiever and leader in the promotion and further study of art or music.

The Jennifer Woodland Scholarship, the recipient must be a female track athlete who best exemplifies the generous and joyous spirit, capacity for caring friendship and the indomitable pursuit of personal improvement and achievement exemplified by Jennifer Woodland.

The Brendan O'Connor Scholarship, the recipient must be a graduating member of the GM Cross Country team, who has contributed the same enthusiasm, leadership and love of the sport in his or her career as Brendan O'Connor.

The Patricia Chaffee Memorial Art Scholarship, given in honor of a former art GMHS teacher, goes to an individual who has shown significant achievement in the Art and plans to pursuing a future in Art.

The Scarlett Science Scholarship, the recipient has demonstrated a love and curiosity for the mysteries of science and nature and who plans to attend college or university to pursue and education in the field of science.

The Dick Dundon Scholarship is chosen by all the head coaches. It is presented to a senior who exhibits the highest qualities of good sportsmanship, exceptional personality, willingness to help others, high scholastic standing, loyalty to beliefs and school, distinguished leadership, as well as excellence in education.

The Raymond Birchard Scholarship, given in memory of veterinarian, school board member, and community leader Dr. Birchard, awards a senior who has demonstrated a willingness to work for the benefit of his or her fellow students and the whole school community.

The PNC Capital Markets Scholarship is presented to a student whose intended major is business.

Dr. Therese T. Walter Scholarship, given to an individual who 'helped it happen,' is in honor of Therese T. Walter, former General McLane superintendent from 1982 through 2005.

The H.G. Gillespie Senior Scholarship, given to an individual who demonstrates good citizenship and character and intends to continue his/her education in a vocational or technical field.

The Gail Orbanek Scholarship, given in memory of Gail Orbanek, a GM graduate and district elementary teacher, to a student intending to major in elementary education who possesses Gail's qualities of kindness, dedication, unselfishness and caring for others. The recipient is chosen by the high school faculty.

The R.A. Fuller Scholarship, given in memory of R.A. Fuller, a businessman, banker and life-long member of the Edinboro community. The recipient is nominated by the Business Faculty and given to a senior intending to major in the field of accounting, banking or finance.

The David Knickerbocker Scholarship, given in memory of David Knickerbocker, a GM graduate, math tutor, district teacher, and tax professional. The scholarship is awarded by his family and the PA Chapter of the National Association of Tax Professionals, and is given to a senior intending to major in math or accounting.

The Danny Woods Scholarship, given in memory of Danny Woods, a GM graduate and life-long supporter of GM athletic programs, awards a senior baseball and softball player/manager who exhibits Danny's same love of the game, positive attitude, enthusiasm and sportsmanship.

The GM Boys Basketball Award, given in memory of Dave Smith, is an award given to senior boys basketball players.

The Gae M. Fuller Nursing Scholarship, created by retired United States Navy Captain Gae M. Fuller, awards a senior committed to becoming a nurse and who will be majoring in nursing at a four-year college or university.

The Jean & Alton Huntley Family Endowment, created in 2017 in memory of Jean and Alton Huntley, is given to a student attending Edinboro University, or a local technical school.
