

Good Evening parents. This is Dan Mennow, Principal of General McLane High School. If you are receiving this call, then your son or daughter is in Cohort 1 for the 2020-2021 school year...

Cohort 1 students will be in the building on Tuesday and Thursday mornings and Wednesday and Friday afternoons. Every Monday is online instruction for all students.

As you know, our school year officially starts tomorrow, Tuesday, August 25th, and your son or daughter will be here in the morning for a 7:45 am start. Here's a couple of reminders for tomorrow morning...

First, if your son or daughter is driving, make sure they enter the north drive and park in the back parking lot. We will be around to issue parking passes in the next few days. If you plan to drive your son or daughter to school, please enter the south driveway and plan to drop them off at the front entrance. If your son or daughter is being bussed to school, the bus garage has already communicated with you regarding pick-up and drop off times.

Second, please make sure your son or daughter either knows or has access to their class schedule. When they arrive in the building, we will ask that they go to first period. In first period, we will give the students their locker assignments and will review the student handbook. In the past, kids had an advisory period. This year, we will use period one or period three to distribute information.

Finally, please make sure students have a face covering and that they bring their fully charged iPads with them every day.
