

Good Evening parents. This is Dan Mennow, Principal of General McLane High School. If you are receiving this call, then your son or daughter has elected to take classes online at General McLane for the 2020-2021 school year. The purpose of this call today is to answer a few of your biggest questions but also to direct you to a resource where more information is available.

First, your son or daughter is enrolled in what we are calling the *GM Cyber Program*. Although this is an online program, they are still enrolled in GM courses that are taught by General McLane teachers. The GM cyber program will begin **Next Tuesday, August 25<sup>th</sup>**. This is the same start date as the live program. On Tuesday, students should log in to Schoology and look for communication and updates from their teachers. There is no specific time that they need to be online. The GM Cyber program will vary from course to course but there is no expectation that kids attend courses at the same time that they are offered here live.

Also, next **Tuesday, August 25<sup>th</sup>, from 3-7 pm** we will be available at the high school for GM Cyber parents or students to come to the high school to pick up class materials. While we are trying to offer online materials as much as possible, there may be a textbook or other materials that will need to be picked up. Teachers will let the GM Cyber kids know if they need to pick up materials. Again, we will be here to distribute those materials next Tuesday from 3-7pm. Enter the school through the main entrance and please be sure to wear a mask.

We put together a Commonly Asked Questions for GM Cyber parents that appears on the General McLane High School main web page. I think you will find answers to questions that were not addressed in this call on that page.

Again, welcome to the GM Cyber program. Classes begin next Tuesday, August 25<sup>th</sup>. Materials can be picked up that same evening from 3-7 pm. If you have any questions that were not answered here or on the Q&A on the webpage, please email or call me any time.
