Q: When do classes start?

A: Cyber classes begin Tuesday, August 25, 2020.

Q: How do I know what classes I have?

A: Login to Schoology to see your course schedule.

Q: I'm a 9th grader. What is my password?

A: The high school passwords are a bit different from the middle school. The password follows this configuration:

#studentID\$Middle initial

Example: #12345678\$A

Q: How do I access my classes?

A: In Schoology, at the left, you will see your courses listed; click on a course to view your course information and materials. Most classes will require materials to be picked up at the high school; pickup times will be Tuesday, August 25 from 3-7 p.m. Use the main entrance and you will be directed to the cafeteria. Please call the high school office at 273-1033 if this day is not good for you.

Q: How often should I "attend" class?

A: You should plan to attend to your schoolwork daily. However, you are not restricted to certain hours of work. Attendance will be determined by the successful completion of daily assignments.

Q: Can I still participate in GM sports and activities?

A: Yes, GM Cyber students are GM students and may participate in sports and activities.

Q: How do I contact my teachers?

A: Students can message their teachers via Schoology, email them, or call the school.

Q: What should I do if I am having trouble in my classes?

A: Start by reaching out to your teacher. Being a cyber student will have challenges, but good communication with your teachers will be important to your success. You also have a guidance counselor here at school; students with IEPs also have a case manager who is here to help you be successful.

Q: Who is my guidance counselor?

A: Guidance counselors are the same as last year:
If your last name starts with A-G: Mrs. Weiss
If your last name starts with H-O: Mrs. Hertel
If your last name starts with P-Z: Mr. Tyree

Q: What if I don't have Internet access or am having connectivity or other technology issues?

A: Please call the high school office and ask to speak to Courtney. She can help with basic troubleshooting or direct your call.

Q: What if I want to come back to school in the building?

A: Talk with your guidance counselor. Obviously, it will be easier to make the transition back at the end of a term.
