General McLane School District remains at **zero** cases of COVID-19 within the student body and staff following this week (September 21-25). This is positive news considering the increase in cases within our community recently. The zip code of 16412 had an increase of 2 positive COVID tests in the past 7 days.

The nurses in each school are seeing a variety of common symptoms among our students. Sore throats, fevers, congestion, and abdominal pain have been frequently reported. These symptoms closely mimic COVID-19. Fortunately, all tested students have come back **negative**.

As a reminder, most children who are sick with COVID-19 are mildly ill, with the most common symptoms being cough and/or fever. Please continue to keep your students home from school with any symptoms on the Daily Checklist. Magnets with the checklist went home with all students this past week.
