



STATEMENT FROM GENERAL MCLANE SCHOOL DISTRICT

November 16, 2020

“We had two cases of COVID-19 over the weekend — a middle school student and a high school student who are siblings. There are no close contacts in the classroom and these students do not ride a bus.

Today we became aware of one case of a high school student and there were no close contacts in the classroom and three close contacts on the bus.

To the date, there has been no spread of the virus in our schools.

The level of virus in our community and Erie County as a whole remains high. As a matter fact the numbers as of yesterday are the highest we've seen to date. Please be extra careful, staying 6 feet from everyone and always wearing a mask. And, don't forget to wash her hands.

We will be having Facebook live again this Thursday at noon.”
