



CALL HOME FROM GENERAL MCLANE SCHOOL DISTRICT

“The good news is that our overall number of cases in the school district community dropped for the 3rd week in a row. The bad news is that we’ve had 6 cases in the high school which now will require the high school only, to go 100% online for the next two days AND we have to cancel extracurriculars at the high school until Wednesday.

The high school is usually online Mondays so that will just be extended one day. In-person classes and extracurriculars will resume on Wednesday.

The other three buildings will continue normal operations. The odd thing about this is that there are 0 cases in the three other buildings that would count toward a temporary closure. Over the weekend we’ve just seen an increase at the high school.

High school staff should check for an email from me with further instructions.”
