Commencement Recording Dates, Times, and Guidelines

Congratulations Seniors and Senior Parents! We are getting close to the end of your senior year. It's time to start planning for the biggest event of the year...Commencement.

This document will provide information for the Photo Days of May 3rd, 4th & 5th. Details for the actual graduation day of June 3rd will be provided in a couple of weeks. Included here are guidelines for dress, costs, procedures, deliveries, and specific report times for each graduate.

Dress:

Seniors must be dressed appropriately. Our commencement has always been a dignified event.

Men: dress pants, dress shoes, black socks, dress shirt, and tie (no bow ties)

Women: dress, skirt, or dress pants, dress shoes

Because we will be holding the Commencement ceremony on the turf at Linden Field, we need to be cautious of the shoes to be worn that evening. High heels can damage the turf and can cause a trip hazard.

RECOMMENDED: flats, wedge heels, or "block" heels (high heels that are at least 1" square)

NOT PERMITTED: stiletto heels, pumps with slim heels, or kitten heels (any heels that are less than 1" square)

All: NO sneakers, NO cowboy boots, NO flip flops, NO jeans, NO shorts, NO athletic wear

- * Seniors should arrive “photo-ready”. They should be wearing the attire described above, hair and make-up should be done and everyone should be ready to be photographed.
- * The graduation gown will be provided at the school. All gowns have been pressed by a professional dry cleaner.
- * Caps may be decorated again this year. Guidelines and ideas for cap decoration will be provided with the cap.
- * If any senior is struggling financially and does not have the means to purchase the dress clothes described above, please email Mr. Mennow privately or reach out to a trusted teacher. We will cover the costs or provide the clothing for anyone that does not have the means to provide it themselves.

Costs:

The graduation fee for this year is \$35.00. This fee will help us defray the cost of the cap and gown. Upon arrival, seniors will progress through stations. One of the stations will be to submit payment.

Please place cash or check (made payable to General McLane High School) in a sealed envelope with the senior’s name on the outside of the envelope. We would prefer to have a check submitted for payment. If you are using cash, please have the exact amount. We will not be handling money on this day.

If a senior is struggling to pay the graduation fee, please email Mr. Mennow privately or reach out to a trusted teacher. We will gladly cover the graduation fee for any senior family that cannot afford the payment.

Procedures:

Students will arrive at the designated time, park in the student parking lot, and progress to the gym lobby with their graduation fee. All students should wear a mask.

Seniors will enter the gym lobby and progress to **Station #1**. Here, they will check in and submit the graduation fee envelope to Mr. Kane.

Next, seniors will enter the main gym for **Station #2**. Here, they will meet Ms. Fritchman and Mr. Haise to receive their cap, gown, tassel and stole at this station. Anyone in need of assistance putting on the cap will receive assistance here. Before leaving for station #3, students will be geared up and ready for a photo.

Next, students will progress to the East side of the cafeteria where they will meet Mrs. Hodas and Mrs. Chelton for **Station #3**. Here, they will take a formal graduation headshot. There is no cost to parents for the headshot. The school and private donors will cover the cost of the headshot. Orders for more headshots can be made through Mrs. Hodas. More information will be provided at the time of the photo.

Next, students will progress to the West side of the cafeteria where they will meet Ms. Mackowski for **Station #4**. At this station students will review their name as it will be printed on their diploma as well as vote for student choice speaker.

Next, Students will Return to the Gym where they will again meet Ms. Fritchman and Mr. Haise for **Station #5**. The students will return their gown, stole, and tassel to be kept at the high school until graduation. Students will take their cap with them and decorate it if they choose to.

After station #5, students will be finished for the day. At this point, they will be heading home.

Deliveries:

Monday, May 3rd, a delivery will be made to every senior's home with a graduation sign (we will plant this in the yard and you can move it wherever you want. There is no cost to seniors for the sign).
