Instructional Model Mitigation Plan

	Total Erie County cases per 100,000 persons in the past 7 days	% positive tests in the past 7 days	Masking requirements in the schools
Low	0 – 9 new cases	<5% testing pcr	Optional
Moderate	10– 49 new cases	5% - 7.9% testing pcr	Optional
Substantial	50-99 new cases	8% - 10% testing pcr	Universal Masking
High	100+ new cases	10+% testing pcr	Universal Masking

In the event of increase spread and/or case clustering, the district may need to move to masking at the discretion of the pandemic coordinator and the superintendent.

Quarantine Update

The CDC and Department of Health require individuals to quarantine if exposed to a positive Covid-19 case.

- Within the classroom and bus setting, 3 feet is used to identify close contacts if both parties are correctly and consistently masked. Outside of these settings, a distance of 6 feet will be used.
- If you are vaccinated and voluntarily provide status, quarantine may not be required.
- Guidelines for quarantine are subject to change as new guidance is released from the CDC or if increased spread is noted within the school/bus setting.
