5. The board moves to approve the following regarding non-resident tuition students (effective March 15, 2023):

- a. The district will not accept non-resident students via tuition other than those required by law (Policy 202).
- b. Non-resident tuition students enrolled in the district at the time of the approval of this policy shall be permitted to continue their enrollment through exhaustion of entitlement to school enrollment privileges under provisions of the Public School Code.
- c. When establishing a tuition rate annually, the district will utilize the PDE-2061 Form. The rates are calculated using financial information reported by each school district on the Annual Financial Report, PDE-2057. School districts can access their Certified Tuition Rate calculation through the Consolidated Financial Reporting System (CFRS).
