## 3rd Grade Supply List 2024-2025

- \_\_\_ 1 2-inch trapper keeper with zipper or velcro close  
(They need these for 4th grade as well, so it is a 2-year investment.)



- \_\_\_ 2 marble covered composition books  
\_\_\_ 1 folder with 3 holes to clip in binder (be sure it fits)  
\_\_\_ 1 or 2 three-ring pencil pouches clipped in binder (with supplies neatly opened and organized) or a pencil case (supplies have to fit inside)  
\_\_\_ 1 pad of 3x3 inch sticky notes  
\_\_\_ Scissors (any size that is comfortable for you)  
\_\_\_ 1 box of broad line markers  
\_\_\_ 1 box of colored pencils  
\_\_\_ 2 packs of pencils (already sharpened if possible)  
\_\_\_ 3 large glue sticks  
\_\_\_ Ear buds for the iPad  
\_\_\_ Flip-top water bottle that is leakproof

Boys: 1 box of tissues

Girls: Gallon or quart size ziplock bags

\*Optional Extras For Your Own Personal Use: Mini Pencil Sharpener, Mechanical Pencil with Lead & Lead Refills (you would be in charge of refilling when empty), Fine Line Black Sharpie (Tracing Projects), Masking Tape for STEM

\*It is always helpful when parents use a sharpie or label to label student supplies with their child's name so if an item is on the floor, we can quickly identify who it belongs to.
