

Flexible Instruction Day

- A Flexible Instruction Day will be used when a weather event makes transportation unsafe for an in-person day.

Elementary Schools

Important Information

- The day counts as an instructional day, and attendance is determined by assignment completion.
- Middle and high school information is noted below. For all buildings, the instructional day is 10:00-2:30.

 - Any times listed are a general guide to ensure students can reach out to teachers through Teams, Schoology, or email with any content-specific questions.
- The day will not include required synchronous instruction.
- Students will be expected to complete course content online and/or as sent home from teachers/school.
- Teachers will be available throughout the day through Microsoft Teams, Schoology, and/or email to provide support as needed.
